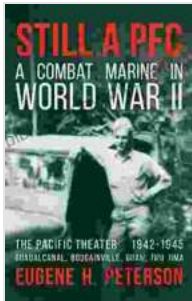

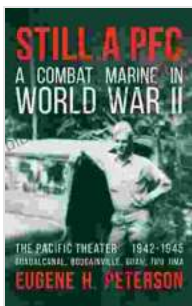
The author of this memoir is a retired Marine who served in World War II. He has been awarded the Purple Heart, the Silver Star, and the Bronze Star.

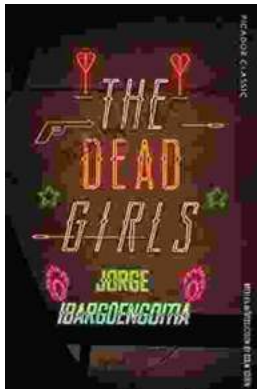
